



# Eureka! 200

Wirral going on a bike ride. Eureka Cafe might be closed but we've now got Nets Cafe at Neston. This Perm is best ridden using the E-Brevet app, but you can still ride with a traditional Brevet Card, if you choose a suitable start time as some of the controls have limited availability.

Section 1: 5km: use the left hand cycle lane through the airport tunnels but watch the curb

Section 3: 15km: the cyclepath passes through a farm yard, concrete surface but might be slippery

Section 4: 7km: a long off-road section on good surfaces between Neston and Saltney Ferry (bridge)






Section 4: 40km: Sandy Lane is well named in places

For a successful validation, you must:

- enter at **[www.delphcyclist.info/EurekaPerm.html](http://www.delphcyclist.info/EurekaPerm.html)** (don't worry about the ride date at this stage)
- register your ride date by texting **07931 911324** or emailing **[mike@PeakAudax.co.uk](mailto:mike@PeakAudax.co.uk)** before you start
- visit all the controls listed below within the time limits - note that this is a non-mandatory route
- establish your "proof of passage" by
  - downloading the **eBrevet** - see **[www.delphcyclist.info/eBrevet.html](http://www.delphcyclist.info/eBrevet.html)**
  - or recording a **GPS track** (must be .GPX format) showing you visited each Control Location
  - or collecting **till receipts** or ATM slips from anywhere at the Control Location
- completing **all** the details on your Brevet Card (name, address, ride date, control locations and times plus your signature) and returning to me within 14 days of your ride

**Controls:** The ride works best using the E-Brevet app or a GPX track to authenticate your ride. The route is advisory, but you should ensure that you pass within ½km of the locations below (indicated by Grid Reference and [what3words.com](http://what3words.com)). If you haven't access to the app or GPX you may still collect receipts from the various suggested locations.

**eBrevet:** Ride Code **MW04** (see [www.DelphCyclist.info/eBrevet.html](http://www.DelphCyclist.info/eBrevet.html) for customisation instructions to reverse the direction, start at any control, or start anywhere between controls).

<b>Dean Row</b>	The route sheet commences from the Petrol Station on A5102 (SJ 873 816) between Stockport and Wilmslow. Parking is available (at your own risk!) in the A5102 layby near the Deanwater Hotel (SJ 877 818, SK7 1RJ). You may start/finish at any other control, although you may need to check opening times to ensure you will be able to obtain proof-of-passage.
